Salisbury University is a Maryland campus on the move. National rankings, innovative new facilities, and a growing reputation for excellence make it a great time to be a Sea Gull.

Located on the scenic Eastern Shore, only 20 miles from the Chesapeake Bay, SU is home to 8,400 students from 28 states and 58 nations. Consistently named among the nation's best by *U.S. News & World Report* and *The Princeton Review*, SU also is a *Kiplinger's Personal Finance* "Best Value" public college.

The University offers 56 academic programs and all four of its schools are endowed — a rarity among public institutions nationwide. Students are encouraged to engage in undergraduate research, study abroad, professional internships, and civic engagement. Exemplary NCAA Division III athletic teams have earned 11 national championships in the past decade.

"These are exciting times at Salisbury University," said President Janet Dudley-Eshbach. "Our reputation as *A Maryland University of National Distinction* is growing." She is leading the way, ushering in a new era with exciting campus transformations.

Brand new this fall is a \$55 million home for the Franklin P. Perdue School of Business. Also changing the skyline is Sea Gull Square, a five-story, 600-bed residence hall and retail complex. In 2008, SU opened its state-of-the-art Teacher Education and Technology Center. Dedicated to environmental sustainability, the campus is pursuing U.S. Green Building Council LEED Silver certification for all new projects — with some going for Gold!

An increasing number of students and parents recognize SU's value. This fall, more than 8,000 applied for just 1,200 seats. *The Princeton Review* has called SU "a rising star in the Northeast" and noted its recent "transformation from regional gem to an internationally recognized institution."
