The Hilton Head Choral Society makes beautiful music year-round for residents and visitors.

For the past 35 years, the Hilton Head Choral Society has graced the island with strong voices, and outstanding arrangements and conducting.

The all-volunteer chorale of more than 100 members presents four concerts each year with orchestral accompaniment and, on occasion, professional soloists.

Concerts feature a diverse repertoire consisting of major classical works and contemporary and seasonal favorites, drawing from pops, gospel, Broadway, and cinematic influences.

The centerpiece of the large ensemble is the multi-talented Tim Reynolds, now in his 12th year as the artistic director and conductor.

The HHCS Presents series periodically brings internationally recognized and acclaimed vocal groups to perform. The Society also stays active during the holiday season, sponsoring an annual Christmas Tour of Homes featuring local residences decorated for the holidays.
