

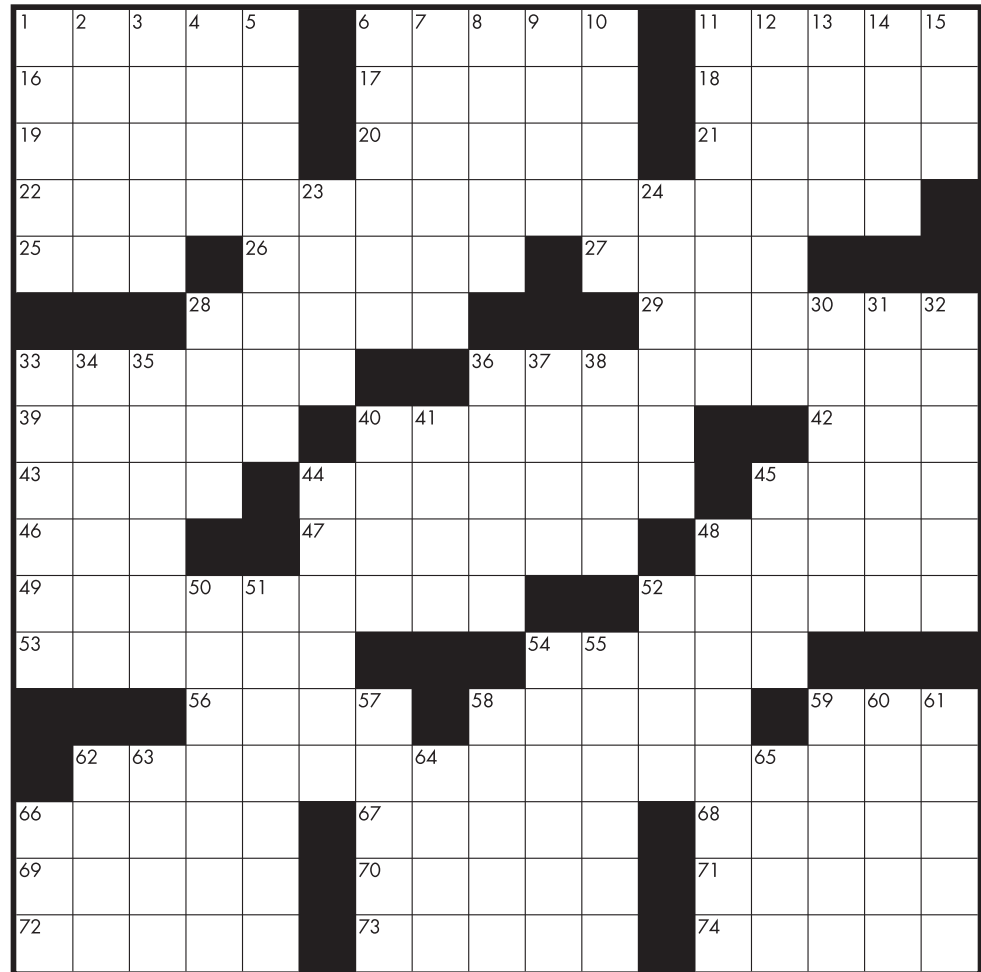
BREAD BOX
