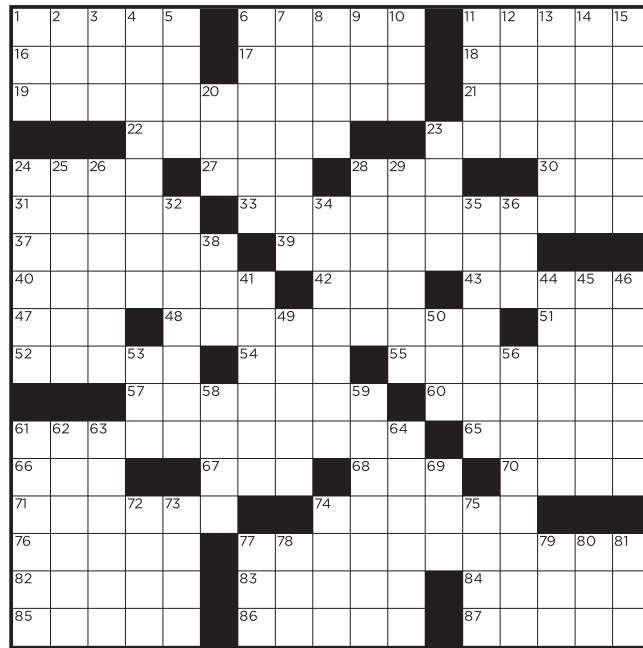


# STARTING FIVE
